

Proposed LSD Restroom Policy

Elementary School:

In the Elementary Department, every classroom has a restroom. The teacher or other staff will monitor the restroom usage.

Middle School and High School:

All restrooms in the school will remain unlocked. The bell schedule and cafeteria procedures will allow extra time for students to use the restrooms during breakfast, after 2nd period, during lunch, after 6th period, and at the end of 7th period, before travelling home or reporting to their after school activities.

Assigned duty staff will monitor the restrooms at to the designated 5 minute class changes after 2nd and 6th periods, and flash the bathroom lights when three minutes of the five minute break have expired.

Daily Restroom Schedule:

Before School – Cafeteria and restrooms will be monitored by duty staff

1st Period-2nd Period – 2 minutes to change classes

2nd Period-3rd Period – 5 minutes to change classes (hallways and restrooms will be monitored by duty staff)

3rd Period-4th Period – 2 minutes to change classes

Lunch (between 4th-5th Period) – Cafeteria and restrooms will be monitored by duty staff

5th Period-6th Period – 2 minutes to change classes

6th Period-7th Period – 5 minutes to change classes (hallways and restrooms will be monitored by duty staff)

After 7th Period (End of School Day) – 5 minutes to use restrooms (hallways and restrooms will be monitored by duty staff)

Emergency Restroom Needs

Students are encouraged to take care of restroom needs during the designated times of the day as outlined in the schedule. As such, emergency restroom passes will be limited to three per class per nine week period, unless otherwise dictated by the student's IEP, Health Plan, or documented medical condition. Students who need to use the restroom during class time will be noted by each teacher each class period and given a hall pass.

Students who use the restroom during class breaks and have missed no instructional time due to emergency classroom passes to use the restroom will earn 15 eagle bucks per teacher per 9 weeks.
